19 Contraindications & your right to refuse

"Your technicians should not perform a pedicure if the client has a broken bone or sprain in the foot or leg and any contraindications. They should also avoid the service if they aren't qualified to deal with a condition presented," says Shona Wright.
 "It's not technicians, it's important to know when something isn't right" stresses Jennie Phillips. "We cannot diagnose conditions and must refer clients to a GP if we have concerns and see a potential contraindication. This could be a change in colour or texture, discoloration, inflammation, swelling or redness."
 "Some conditions can be checks for us to treat, such as clients with diabetes or clients who have varicose, as these are highly contagious," says Hannah Clayton. "I would advise clients to seek medical advice and treatment. Then accept a booking once the problem is treated."

"Regularly create video content for social services, focusing on the city-gifts parts of the treatment so that clients know what to expect," explains Jenna Pedlow. "Take the photos before and after images and client testimonials."

21 Deal with damaged toenails

"Toenail trauma is very common and is caused through abuse or impact," says Marie Espino. "Depending on the severity of the trauma, damage can cause loss of the nail and infection." "There's a lot of clients that are very active, with toenails that have been damaged from running and walking and feet burnable dropped on them," shares Hannah Clayton. "If toenails are damaged in any way, I remove them and, if safe, perform a basic pedicure with rubber top and oil to keep."

"Some of my clients do a lot of running, which results in bruising or sometimes loss of nails from the impact and pressure," explains Pam Stone. 25 Diabetes focus

Clients with diabetes are at a higher risk of developing foot problems due to frequent blood sugar levels, which can damage the sensitivity in their feet. Reduced blood supply to the feet, due to the impact diabetes can have on blood circulation, can cause delayed healing of cuts and sores, swelling or foot cramps and pain.

"If your client has diabetes, you should always ask GP advice before carrying out a pedicure," says Lisa Stone.
